
From DUBLIN to ACHILL by car (aproxx 4-5 hours).



Be aware that toll has to be prepaid on the M50. Check out on www.eflow.ie how to pay your toll.

The route

In Dublin follow the signs to "The West".

From the Airport you drive to the M1.

Take the "South Bound" of the M50, this is M1/M50 to all other directions (N2/N3/N4/N5 etc.).



There is a toll to be prepaid. Check out on www.eflow.ie how to pay your toll.

From the M50 you have to take the N4/M4, which direct you to "The West", Castlebar, Westport, Sligo.

Take the M4 and N4 to MULLINGAR and LONGFORD.

A motorway, called the M4 goes from Dublin in westerly direction. You get off at Kinnegad towards Mullingar and Longford. On the motorway you have to pay a toll (around \in 3.--) for using it. There is a person who takes your money.

At the second traffic lights in the center of Longford you follow the signs to Castlebar/Westport and go to the left.

Now take the N5 to TULSK, CHARLESTOWN and CASTLEBAR/WESTPORT.

In Ballaghadereen don't miss out the junction to the right. Immediately after you turn from the market to the left there is a right you have to take.



In Castlebar follow the signs Westport. At the third roundabout follow the signs for Newport and Achill.



From Castlebar take the R311 to Achill, pass through NEWPORT and MULRANNY.

From Mulranny follow the signs to ACHILL. Watch out for sheep on the road!
